On June 25 (Sunday), at 2:00 pm: at Barbara Winters': Valley Forge Chapter Picnic and Annual Meeting Barbara Winters, 936 Shenkel Road, Pottstown, PA 19465

Barbara Winters backyard is a location where hundreds of mules once grazed in between trips up and down the Schuylkill Canal. This left a good legacy of soil along the mule path where the rhododendrons flourish by the dozens. This very large property was purchased in 1754 from descendants of William Penn.

Bring a salad, vegetable, or dessert serving 4 – 6 and your own eating utensils and chairs. Meat and beverages will be provided. We encourage new members or members who have never attended before simply to join in the fun and bring along their families or gardening friends.

There will be a brief business meeting (election of officers) and time to visit their garden.

Directions

From US-422: Take PA-100 South.

About ¹/₄ mile south of US422, turn right onto PA-724W (W Schuylkill Rd) towards Birdsboro.

After 1.4 mi. turn left onto Catfish Lane. After 0.6 mi. turn right onto Valley View Rd. After 0.7 mi. turn right onto Temple Rd. Then immediately turn right onto Shenkel Rd. Barbara is 0.8 miles down Shenkel on the right.

From Bucktown: Take PA-100 North.

About 2.0 miles north of PA-23, turn left onto W. Hoffecker Rd.

After 0.5 mi. turn right onto Laurewood Rd. After 0.1 mi. cross Temple Rd onto Shenkel Rd.

Barbara is 0.8 miles down Shenkel on the right.

It is not too early to start planning for the ARS meeting next May in Northern Europe. This will be one of the most extensive rhododendron meetings ever offered. The Preand Post-Tours are optional and hosted by the European ARS chapters. The actual Convention will be in Bremen Germany. Here are some of the activities currently planned.

May 6-12: Pre-Tour 1, Holland

Visit many public and private gardens including the famous bulb display at Keukenhof.

May 13–14: Pre-Tour 2, Germany Visit the RHODO 2018 Exposition in Westerstede as well as the Hobbie and Hachmann Nurseries.

May 15–20: Pre-Tour 3, Denmark/Sweden Tour south Sweden and Denmark visiting private gardens, public gardens, and a castle. May 21-26: ARS Convention, Germany This is the main part of the convention with several days of tours to spectacular public gardens or nurseries during the day and banquets and speakers in the evenings. May 27–31: Post-Tour, Finland

Fly to Helsinki from Bremen and tour Finnish gardens for 3 days before flying home.
