1:30-2 p.m.: Staging of cuttings

3 or 4 large-leaf (elepidote) or 4-6 small-leaf (lepidote) cuttings, preferably taken early in the morning and low on the plants, may be put into a plastic bag with a few drops of water. Named varieties only, please. Please label the bags with a water-proof marker or pencil.

2:00 p.m.: Cuttings exchange/sale

Anyone is eligible to buy cuttings at 25 cents a bag. Propagating from cuttings is an excellent and inexpensive way to increase your collection of azaleas and rhododendrons.

2:30 p.m.: Plant Auction. Auctioneer: Hank Schannen

Please donate rhodies and azaleas as well as other garden-worthy plants that you feel others might like. Be prepared for lively bidding! Some of the donations are one-of-a-kind hybrids or very special plants.

3:00 p.m.: Propagation Demonstration-Optional

For those interested in learning from the experts.

At about 3:30 p.m.: Dessert

Please bring *your* favorite **fingerfood** dessert. You also may bring a box lunch and eat it any time. Seating is limited, so please **bring your own chairs**. **Beverages will be provided**.

Directions:

From the South: Take the Pennsylvania Turnpike (the northeast extension) North to the Quakertown exit. Turn right at the exit onto route 663 towards Pennsburg. At the traffic light in Pennsburg, turn right onto Route 29. Continue on Route 29 to Pinetree Road (the road sign is on the left in front of the Fire House, but the road comes off on the right side; this is just before the Route 100 sign. If you come to the traffic light at Route 100 you have gone too far). Turn right on Pinetree Road and drive about 100 yards to Springhill Road, the first left. Turn left on Springhouse Road about 100 yards to Orthaus Road, the first right. Turn right on Orthaus Road and continue about one mile to our driveway (Orthaus Road becomes Ridge Road as it passes into Lehigh county. Our number is on the green mailbox: is 6826 Ridge Road on the right.)

From the Southwest: Take Route 100 to Route 29. Turn right onto Route 29 and drive about 100 yards to Pinetree Road. Turn left on Pinetree Road about 100 yards to Springhill Road, the first left. Turn left on Springhouse Road about 100 yards to Orthaus Road, the first right. Turn right on Orthaus Road and continue about one mile to our driveway (Orthaus Road becomes Ridge Road as it passes into Lehigh county. Our number is on the green mailbox: is 6826 Ridge Road on the right.)

From the West or East: Take Route 78 to the Pennsylvania Turnpike. Go south on the turnpike one exit to Quakertown. Turn right at the exit onto route 663 towards Pennsburg. At the traffic light in Pennsburg, turn right onto Route 29. Continue on Route 29 to Pinetree Road (the road sign is on the left in front of the Fire House, but the road comes off on the right side; this is just before the Route 100 sign. If you come to the traffic light at Route 100 you have gone too far). Turn right on Pinetree Road and drive about 100 yards to Springhouse Road, the first left. Turn left on Springhouse Road about 100 yards to Orthaus Road, the first right.
